Hospitality

Arrival

At the arrival time we need space to unload our equipment as close to the load-in dock as possible. We need free parking slots for 3 cars near the venue. If only paid parking is available nearby, compensation for parking is required for 3 vehicles.

Soundcheck

Since we perform with backing tracks, a soundcheck of at least 30 minutes is required. The time for load-in and setup should be separate from these 30 minutes. The PA system and FOH console should be set up and fully operational by the agreed soundcheck time.

Backstage

A safe place for at least 6 people (band + 2 crew member) is required with at least 6 seats, one table, one mirror and 5 towels. A high speed Wifi connection should be present and password should be provided to the band members.

Catering

For shows after 17:00 hs we would appreciate a nice warm meal for 6 people, please keep in mind that one of our members is vegetarian. For shows before 17:00 hs a variety of snacks or sandwiches would suit. Drinks such as sodas, water, tea, coffee, beer for at least 6 people are required.

Merchandising

A table with a small lamp should be present at the venue for merchandising, preferably in the same room as the stage, or close by the entrance.

Gear

Vocals

- Sennheiser EW-D 835 wireless mic (823-865 MHz)

Backing Vocals

- Shure SM58 wired mic

Guitar

- Pedalboard / amp modeler with direct balanced output to FOH

Bass

- Aguilar Tone Hammer 500 with direct balanced output to FOH
- Pedalboard

Drums

- Kick, snare, hi-hat, tom 1, tom 2, floor tom 1, floor tom 2, crash 1, crash 2, ride

Backing Tracks

- Vocal backing tracks will be controlled from an SPD SX Pro left to drums
- 2x balanced jack output for backing track, will bring own jack to xlr male converters
- 1x wired in-ears.

Video Backdrop & Banners

- 2x roll-up side banner (90cm x 200cm each) to be placed at both sides of the stage
- If available, we'd love access to a projector for backdrop visuals (minimum 1080p resolution). We'll need direct HDMI access to connect our visuals.

We need

- A drum riser of 2 x 2 meters
- All needed mic stands
- All microphones for drums (see FOH Patchlist for details)
- All cables for mics
- Stagebox to FOH
- PA system
- Stage backdrop projection screen
- Projector (minimum 1080p resolution)

In case we have to play on the venue's backline (drumkit) please communicate this with the band ahead of time. In that case the drummer will bring his breakables (cymbals, snare, pedals, etc). We do not need cabinets.
